



The 13th Youth World Cup Painting Competition

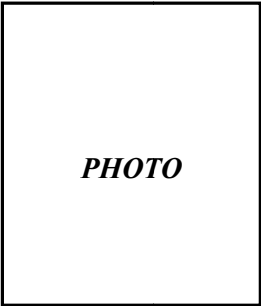

★Important Reminder★

1. Painting Submission and Applications:

(1) The size of the painting paper: from 18in X 12in to 36 in X 24in ; Paper smaller than 12x18 inches and larger than 24x36 inches are not eligible for review.

(2) Description of the painting in English amounting to 200-250 words shall be provided by the contestant;

2. Appraisal Criterion:

(1) Transparency, fairness and openness;

(2) Contestants are to be made 4 groups : Infants: Age 4-6; Children: Age 7-12; Juvenile: Age 13-17; Youth: Age 18-25;

(3) Criterion: Theme 20%; Creativity 20%; Color 20%; Technique 20%; Composition 20%;

(The Jury Panel will make the final decision if any dispute arises.)

3. Competition Prizes:

(1) Every age group will receive (The actual prize number depends on the number of contestants): First Prize (Gold Medal); Second Prize (Silver Medal); Third Prize (Bronze Medal) , Excellence Prize.

(2) All contestants will receive a certificate issued by the Organizing Committee.

4. Support Competition:

Invite friends and relatives to participate in the competition.
